

“ASIA YOUTH LEADERS 2019” OUTLINE (Asia Youth Leaders 2019 in Vietnam)

“ASIA YOUTH LEADERS” is one of the programs to promote friendship with foreign countries held by AEON 1% CLUB FOUNDATION. In this program, high school students from Asian countries get together to discuss social issues in English as a common language. It aims students from different backgrounds cultivate attitudes that are accepting global perspectives and each other’s values through discussion.

1. Theme : SHOKUIKU (Dietary Education Final Round)

“Proposals to healthy dietary habit for youth in Asia” (Temp.)

2. Concept: “Environment” was the theme for the past 7 programs and have made a wide range of discussion. Since 2017, the theme was set on “Dietary education” and we have carried out various programs for three years. This time, in a turning point of 10th anniversary of “ASIA YOUTH LEADERS” and in “Mekong–Japan Exchange Year 2019”, we add Cambodia, Laos, and Myanmar to invite students to the program. The Program aims to learn various types of eating habit to find out issues to solve, and make a proposal of measures for improvement through team discussion.

3. Frame of Discussion :

- The students are divided into a team of about 9 members. A team discusses what they learn through lecture, experience in the field with a customer point of view, or with a global leader’s point of view (Enterprise) or with a Asean leaders’ point of view (Government). They will make a presentation on a final day of the program.
- A theme for discussion for presentation can be selected voluntarily. It will be explained at an orientation on 1st day.
- A research or study of each nation will be an assignment in advance.
